



	Document M (or Doc M) of the Building Regulations is one of a number of documents providing practical guidance for access to and use of buildings. Doc M is split into 2 parts, volume one covers dwellings (domestic / residential dwellings) and volume 2 covers buildings other than dwellings (non domestic / residential dwellings).
